6.27 AT&T 30 MONTHLY MINUTES (CPMMM)

6.27.1 GENERAL

New or existing Customers of AT&T Consumer Telecommunications Services who are presubscribed to AT&T as their Primary Interexchange Carrier must have enrolled in this plan by April 30, 2001.

With this plan, Customers are entitled up to 30 minutes of domestic Dial Station usage. Intrastate Dial Station usage over and above the monthly minute allotment will be rated with the rate schedules in Section 5.3.7 of this tariff.

The Customer may place as many eligible calls as desired for each Customer Main Billed Account during a billing month to accumulate the time used.

All other types of calls are rated at basic rates unless the customer is enrolled in another AT&T plan that covers these other types of calls.
