## 6.29 AT&T 250 WEEKEND MINUTE PLAN (BLKGC)

## 6.29.1 GENERAL

This plan offers customers a weekend block-of-time of up to 250 direct dialed station state-to-state and in-state long distance minutes with a per minute rate on all direct dialed instate minutes not included in the weekend block-of-time.

To be eligible for this offer, customers must 1)currently have, or choose AT&T as their Primary interexchange carrier, 2) enroll in this plan by completing and returning a written subscription form, calling a designated AT&T 800 number to subscribe or by subscribing during a marketing contact with AT&T.

This plan includes AT&T direct dialed station state-to-state and instate calls that are 1) made from the customer's home, 2) billed to the customers' main residential telephone account, 3) made without using an AT&T Operator or an AT&T automated call processing system.
