Formerly known as AT&T International AnyWhere Plan and  
AT&T International AnyWhere Plan II

### 6.35.1 GENERAL

This plan is available to customers who have AT&T as their Primary Long Distance Carrier and are enrolled in this plan.

Eligible AT&T Dial Station calls will be rated using the following schedule below. Intrastate rates for AT&T CIID/891 Automated Calling Card Calls made via 1-800-CALLATT will also be billed as described below.

### 6.35.2 RATES AND CHARGES

Eligible AT&T direct dial station and AT&T Calling Card in-state long distance calls will be rated at a maximum per minute of use rate all day, seven days a week as defined below:
