3.1 CONNECTIONS OF TERMINAL EQUIPMENT AND COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS (Cont'd)

3.1.10 CONNECTIONS WITH CERTAIN FACILITIES OF AIRLINE COMPANIES AND FEDERAL AVIATION AGENCY

- a. Except as otherwise provided in b. following, facilities provided by an Air Common Carrier, its authorized communications agency, or The Federal Aviation Agency to communicate with aircraft in flight may, in lieu of the provisions of 3.1.3 and 3.1.6 preceding, be connected, by means of connecting equipment furnished by the Company, to Company facilities located on the premises of the subscriber for Message Telecommunications Service in cases of emergency involving the safety of life or property.
- b. Terminal equipment and communications systems connected to the telecommunications network in accordance with a. preceding prior to January 1, 1980 may remain connected and be moved and reconnected for the life of the equipment without registration unless subsequently modified. New installations of terminal equipment and communications systems subject to Part 68 of the Federal Communications Commission's Rules and Regulations must be connected to the telecommunications network in accordance with 3.1.2 preceding.
