3.2. CONNECTIONS TO PRIVATE LINE SERVICES (Cont'd)

3.2.3 RESPONSIBILITY OF THE COMPANY

Where terminal equipment or communications systems are used with Private Line Services, the responsibility of the Company shall be limited to the furnishing of service components suitable for Private Line Services and for the maintenance and operation of service components in a manner proper for such services. Subject to this responsibility the Company shall not be responsible for (i) the through transmission of signals generated by the terminal equipment or communications systems or for the quality of, or defects in, such transmission, or (ii) the reception of signals by terminal equipment or communications systems, or (iii) address signaling where such signaling is performed by signaling equipment.

The Company will, at the Customer's request, provide information concerning interface parameters, including the number of ringers which may be connected to a particular line, needed to permit terminal equipment to operate in a manner compatible with the telecommunications network.

The Company may make changes in its telecommunications equipment, operations or procedures, where such action is not inconsistent with Part 68 of the Federal Communication Commission's Rules and Regulations. If such changes can be reasonably expected to render any Customer's terminal equipment or communications system incompatible with the telecommunications network or require modification or alteration of such terminal equipment or communications systems, or otherwise materially affect its use or performance, the Customer will be given adequate notice, in writing, to allow the Customer an opportunity to maintain uninterrupted service.
