### 3.1 CONNECTIONS OF TERMINAL EQUIPMENT AND COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS (Cont'd)

#### 3.1.4 ACOUSTIC OR INDUCTIVE CONNECTIONS

##### A. General

1. Voice or data terminal equipment (including telephotograph equipment) and communications systems may be acoustically or inductively connected at the Customer's premises to the telecommunications network provided the acoustic or inductive connection is made externally to the network control signaling unit when such unit is provided by the Company.
2. Tone-type address signaling is permitted through such connections, however, the services of the Company are not designed for such use and the Company makes no representation as to the reliability of address signaling which is performed in such manner.
