5.3 AT&T LONG DISTANCE SERVICE (Cont'd)

5.3.2 COLLECTION OF CHARGES

- A. Charges for all classes of telephone calls are billed against or collected from the calling telephone in all cases except under the following conditions:
1. Charges may be billed against or collected from the called telephone (i.e., charges may be reversed) if the charges are accepted at the called station, except as shown in 4. and 5. following.
 2. Charges may be billed to an authorized telephone as determined by the Company, other than the telephone originating the call or the telephone where the call is terminated (i.e., charges may be billed to a third number), except as shown in 4. following. Calls through the New York State Relay Center may be billed only to a third number within New York State.
 3. Charges may be billed to an authorized Calling Card number. Calls through the New York State Relay Center may be billed only to a New York State Calling Card number or to a Credit/Charge Card or an AT&T Prepaid Card. Customer Dialed Calling Card Station rates do not apply when
 - (1) the Customer dials the appropriate AT&T access code and does not enter the called number prior to the call timing out and being transferred to a live AT&T operator or the automated operator system; or
 - (2) the Customer dials an AT&T designated number for completion of Customer Dialed Calling Card Calls, but fails to respond to system prompts and must be transferred to a Company Operator. Customer Dialed Calling Card Station rates will apply to calls utilizing the operator system to initiate speed dialed calls. Customer Dialed Calling Card Station rates apply when calls are originated as follows.

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
