5.3.2 COLLECTION OF CHARGES (Cont'd)

- D. Collect calls to coin telephones and transfers of charges to third telephones which are coin telephones will not be accepted.
- E. Collect calls cannot be connected using Audiographics Teleconference Bridge Service.
- F. The New York State Relay Center will complete calls originating from public or semi-public phones if the Customer chooses an AT&T CIID/891 Card or LEC issued Card as an alternative method of payment.

The following calls may not be placed through the New York State Relay Center:

- (1) Calls to 976 or 900 numbers.
- (2) Calls to time or weather recorded messages.
- (3) Calls to other informational recordings.
- (4) Station Sent Paid calls from Coin Telephones.
- (5) Operator Handled Conference Service and other teleconference calls.
- (6) All calls billed to Cards (i.e., Credit Cards and Calling Cards) other than those referred to in Section 5.3.2.A.
- (7) Cellular calls
