- A . Customer Dialed (Cont'd)
 - a. Dial Station (Cont'd)
 - 3. A call is forwarded by Call-Forwarding Equipment.
 - 4. A Company Operator places a call for a calling party who identifies himself/herself as being handicapped and unable to dial the call because of his/her handicap,
 - 5. A Company Communications Assistant at the New York State Relay Center completes a call between persons with hearing and/or speech disabilities who use a Text Telephone (TT) or its equivalent and hearing persons who use an ordinary telephone (the completed call is rated and billed as a call from the calling station to the called station),
 - 6. A Company Operator places a call because Automatic Number Identification (0+) is not available for dial completion.
