5.3 AT&T LONG DISTANCE SERVICE (Cont'd)

5.3.1 CLASSES OF SERVICE (CONT'D)

B. Operator Assisted

1. Operator Dialed Calling Card Station

Operator Dialed Calling Card Station rates apply when

- (1) the Customer dials the appropriate AT&T access code (e.g., 00, or 10288, 0) and does not enter the called number prior to the call timing out and being transferred to a live AT&T operator or the automated operator system, and the completed call is billed to a Calling Card; or
- (2) the Customer dials an AT&T designated number for completion of Customer Dialed Calling Card Calls, but fails to respond to system prompts and must be transferred to a Company operator, and the completed call is billed to a Calling Card.

2. Operator Station

Operator Station rates apply when calls are completed with the assistance of a Company Operator, except as specified for the Dial Station, Customer Dialed Calling Card Station, Operator Dialed Calling Card Station, Person-to-Person and Real Time Rated classes of service. Different rates may apply when Operator Station calls are billed to an AT&T CIID/891 card. Operator Station rates apply to:

- (1) Calls which are billed to a different telephone number (e.g., collect, bill to a third number) or a calling card.
- (2) Calls originated by dialing the appropriate operator code (e.g., 00, 10+10+288+0) and
- (3) paid for by depositing coins at a local telephone company or interexchange carrier owned public or semi-public telephones.

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
