5.3.7 INITIAL AND ADDITIONAL PERIOD RATES

The rates shown in the following tables are the initial minute and additional minute rates applicable to Dial Station, Customer Dialed Calling Card Station, Operator Dialed Calling Card Station, Operator Station, Real Time Rated and Person calls offered by the company between points in New York State. For the added charges for Operator Handled Calls, see 5.3.8. following.

Public and semi-public coin telephones that use network coin signaling will not be suitably equipped to accept payment by coin for AT&T long distance calls. Alternative payment methods such as calling card, commercial credit card, billed-to-third number, collect and AT&T prepaid card may be used for AT&T calls made from such telephones.
