5.3.5 AT&T CIID/891 CARD ADJUSTMENT FACTOR

Provides an adjustment factor which is applied to the total charges of domestic and International calls placed from public and semi public telephones and billed to a Customer's AT&T CIID/891 Card. Also, provides an adjustment factor which is applied to the total charges of domestic and International calls placed from all other telephones and billed to a Customer's AT&T CIID/891 Card. The adjustment factors do not apply to any calls that are already discounted under an Optional Calling Plan or a Custom Network Service.
