SECTION 5-MESSAGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICE (MTS)

5.1 GENERAL

MTS is the furnishing of facilities for telephone communication in accordance with the regulations and schedules of charges specified in this Tariff. The charges specified in this Tariff are in payment for all service furnished between the calling and called telephone, except as otherwise provided in this Tariff. The following are in addition to the General Regulations described in Section 2 of this Tariff.

5.1.1 PRIORITY OF SERVICE

In case a shortage of facilities exists at any time either for temporary or protracted periods, the establishment of AT&T Long Distance Service shall take precedence over all other Company services.

5.1.2 LIMITED CONVERSATION

The Company reserves the right to limit the length of conversation when necessary in times of emergency resulting in a shortage of facilities.

5.1.3 OBLIGATION OF CUSTOMER

The calling party (or Customer) shall establish his or her identity in the course of any communication as often as may be necessary.

The calling party (or Customer) shall be solely responsible for establishing the identity of the person or persons with whom connection is made at the called station.
