2.1 UNDERTAKING OF THE COMPANY (Cont'd)

2.1.5 Customer Equipment

A Customer may transmit or receive messages, information or signals via the facilities or services of the Company by use of Customer-provided equipment.

A. Station Equipment

Customer-provided equipment on the Customer premises, and the electric power consumed by such equipment, shall be provided by and maintained at the expense of the Customer.

The Customer is responsible for ensuring that Customer-provided equipment and wiring connected to Company equipment, facilities, or services is compatible with such Company-provided equipment, facilities or services. The magnitude and character of the voltages and currents impressed on Company-provided equipment, facilities or services wiring by the connection, operation or maintenance of such Customer-provided equipment, facilities or services must be such as not to cause damage to the Company-provided equipment, facilities or services wiring or injury to the Company's employees or other persons. If the Company, in its sole discretion, reasonably determines that additional protective equipment is required to prevent such damage or injury, it shall be provided at the Customer's expense.
