SECTION 2 – GENERAL REGULATIONS

2.4 AUTOMATIC NUMBER IDENTIFICATION

2.4.1 Terms and Conditions

AT&T will provide Automatic Number Identification (ANI) associated with local service provisioned under this tariff, to any entity (ANI recipient) only under the following terms and conditions:

1. The ANI recipient or its designated billing agent may use or transmit ANI information to third parties for billing and collection, routing, screening, ensuring network performance, and completion of a telephone Customer's call or transaction, or for performing a service directly related to the telephone Customer's original call or transaction.
2. The ANI recipient may offer to any telephone Customer with whom the ANI recipient has an established Customer relationship, a product or service that is directly related to products or services previously purchased by the telephone Customer from the ANI recipient.
3. The ANI recipient or its designated billing agent is prohibited from utilizing ANI information to establish marketing lists or to conduct outgoing marketing calls, except as permitted by the preceding paragraph, unless the ANI recipient obtains the prior written consent of the telephone Customer permitting the use of ANI information for such purposes. The foregoing provisions notwithstanding, no ANI recipient or its designated billing agent may utilize ANI information if prohibited elsewhere by law.
4. The ANI recipient or its designated billing agent is prohibited from reselling, or otherwise disclosing ANI information to any other third party for any use other than those listed in 1. above, unless the ANI recipient obtains the prior written consent of the Customer permitting such resale or disclosure.
5. Telephone Corporations must make reasonable efforts to adopt and apply procedures designed to provide reasonable safeguards against the aforementioned abuses of ANI.
