2.2 LIABILITY OF THE COMPANY (Cont'd)

2.2.3 Indemnification by Customer

The Customer and any authorized users jointly and severally shall indemnify, defend and hold the Company harmless against claims, loss, damage and expense (including attorneys' fees and court costs) for libel, slander, or infringement of copyright arising from the material transmitted over its facilities; against claims for infringement of patents arising from combining with or using in connection with, facilities of the Company, equipment and systems of the Customer; and against all other claims, including but not limited to injuries to persons or property from voltage or currents, arising out of any act or omission of the Customer in connection with facilities provided by the Company or the Customer. In the event any such infringing use is enjoined by the Customer at its option and expense, shall obtain immediately a dismissal or stay of such injunction, obtain a license or other agreement so as to extinguish any claim of infringement, or terminate the claimed infringing use or modify such infringement.

2.2.4 Customer Provided Equipment

The services and facilities furnished by the Company, in addition to the limitations set forth in this Tariff, also are subject to the following limitation: the Company shall not be liable for damage arising out of mistakes, omissions, interruptions, delays, errors or defects in transmission or other injury, including but not limited to injuries to persons or property from voltages or currents transmitted over the facilities of the Company caused by Customer provided equipment or premises wire.

2.2.5 Credit Limitation

Credits attributable to any billing period under Paragraph 2.2.1. preceding, shall not exceed the total charges for that period for the services and facilities furnished by the Company rendered useless or substantially impaired.
