6.64 AT&T 60 MONTHLY MINUTES (BLKSB) (formerly known as AT&T Block of Time Promotion No. 3)

6.64.1 GENERAL

This offer is an add-on to the interstate offer described in AT&T's Service Guide located at www.att.com/serviceguide/home.

This plan offers customers a block-of-time of up to 60 direct dialed station state-to-state and in-state long distance minutes.

To participate in this plan, customers must have AT&T as their primary interexchange carrier and be enrolled in this plan by April 24, 2006.

This plan includes AT&T direct dialed station state-to-state and in-state calls that are 1) made from the customer's home, 2) billed to the customer's main residential telephone account, 3) made without using an AT&T Operator or an AT&T automated call processing system.

This plan, as described in the AT&T Consumer Service Guide, includes up to 60 minutes of direct dialed station state-to-state and in-state long distance calling each month.

Unused block-of-time minutes will not be carried over to the next month.

AT&T will rate all instate direct dialed station minutes beyond the monthly minute allotment as defined below:
