6.3 AT&T REACH OUT STATE SERVICE

Customers who currently subscribe to this service may retain it at the same address and telephone number. No additional requests for this service will be accepted beyond the effective date of this leaf.

6.3.1 GENERAL

AT&T Reach Out State Service is an optional Calling Plan available to Residence Subscribers and Centrex dormitory service subscribers. The plan permits these Subscribers to dial calls directly anytime during a day.

6.3.2 REGULATIONS

- 1. The service applies only to directly dialed Station Service intrastate messages originating at the Subscriber's residence or dormitory Centrex telephone.
- 2. The service applies to calls occurring anytime during a day.
- 3. Message details are not included in the basic charges for AT&T Reach Out State Service. Message details may be furnished at the Subscriber's request at the rates specified.
- 4. All usage of a multi-line Subscriber with one billing number is included in the service.
- 5. The service is furnished for a minimum period of one month.
