C. Charges (Cont'd)

2. Monthly Allowance and Charges

No charge applies for:

- (a) Requests for telephone numbers of non-published service, as defined by the LEC tariff.
- (b) Those Customers with disabilities who qualify for exemptions from the local Directory Assistance charges under Local Exchange Company tariff(s) are exempted, as a reasonable accommodation associated with their disability, from the Directory Assistance charge for up to and including 50 calls per monthly billing cycle. This exemption applies to calls billed to one residential telephone line per disabled Customer and applies to Directory Assistance calls for personal use only. Calls in excess of 50 will be billed the tariffed Directory Assistance charges.
- (c) Calls for Directory Assistance from persons who have requested exemption from the Directory Assistance Charge because they are unable to use telephone directories due to a reading impairment. The method of exempting each Customer shall be determined by the LEC.
