2.18 EXPLANATION OF TERMS (Cont'd)

Intercept Line

A line connecting a central office line to equipment for answering incoming calls.

Interface

That point on the premises of the Subscriber at which provision is made for connection of other than Company provided facilities to facilities provided by the Company.

Interoffice Mileage

The segment of a line which extends between the Company's Point of Presence serving the originating and terminating points.

Leased Channel

See Tariff P.S.C. No. 3--Telephone.

Local Access and Transport Area (LATA)

The term "Local Access and Transport Area" denotes a geographic area established for the administration of communications service. It encompasses designated exchanges, including those of Independent Companies, which are grouped to serve common social, economic and other purposes. In New York State, there are six LATAS and the Rochester Market Area (which is listed with the LATAs). They are as follows:
