2.18 EXPLANATION OF TERMS (Cont'd)

Terminal Equipment

The term "Terminal Equipment" denotes devices or apparatus and their associated wiring, provided by a Customer, which do not constitute a multi-line terminating system or a communications system and which when connected the communications path of the telecommunications network, are connected either electrically, acoustically or inductively.

Termination of Service

Discontinuance of both incoming and outgoing service.

Tie Line

A line connecting two switchboards or dial systems.

Toll Call

See "Message Telecommunications Call"

Two-Point Lines

Lines which have one originating and one terminating point.
