### 2.18 EXPLANATION OF TERMS (Cont'd)

## Speed of Service

Channels and equipment for 60 speed teletypewriter service permit the transmission of a maximum of 45 baud; channels and equipment for 75 speed teletypewriter service permit the transmission of a maximum of 56 baud; channels and equipment for 100 speed teletypewriter service permit the transmission of a maximum of 75 baud; channels and equipment for 150 baud teletypewriter service permit the transmission of binary signals at rates up to 150 baud.

## State Agencies

State Agencies are any department, board, bureau, commission, division, office, council, institution or committee in the executive, legislative or judicial branches of the state government; the City University of New York when acting on behalf of any of its senior colleges; the Facilities Development Corporation; or the State University Construction Fund.

### Suspension

Suspension of service for non-payment is interruption of outgoing service only by the LEC. Suspension of service at the Subscriber's request is interruption of both incoming and outgoing service.

## Telephone Grade Lines

Lines furnished for voice transmission or for certain signaling purposes.

# Teletypewriter Grade Lines

Lines furnished for operation of teletypewriters or Morse service and for leased channels for certain purposes.

## **Temporary Suspension**

A suspension of service interrupting both incoming and/or outgoing service on all or part of the subscriber's central office lines, for a temporary period of time.
