## 2.12 AT&T CARD SERVICES

# 1. AT&T Calling Card

The AT&T Calling Card is a card authorized by this Company to which charges for an MTS call may be billed.

### 2. AT&T CALL ME Card

The AT&T CALL ME Card is a restricted type of AT&T Card. Calls charged to an AT&T CALL ME Card can be completed only to the line number appearing on the card. Charges for such calls are the same as standard AT&T Calling Card charges.

# 3. Special Coin AT&T Card

Disabled persons who have been certified to the LEC as legally blind, visually disabled or physically disabled, or persons who have been certified to the LEC as having limitations in use of a coin telephone because of difficulty with hand and finger coordination, will receive, upon application to the LEC, a Special AT&T Card.

Intrastate Station calls made from coin telephones with the Special AT&T Card will be billed at Station dial-type coin rates or AT&T Card rates, whichever is lower.

Person, interstate, non-coin, and request for Time and Charges calls charged to Special Coin AT&T Card Service will be billed at standard Tariff rates.
