#### 9.2.1 Interoffice Channel (Cont'd)

- C. Multiple Channel Pricing Discount - Multiple Channel Pricing (MCP) is available as a discount to conventional monthly rate plans for subrate 9.6 kbps or DSO 56/64 kbps Inter Office Channels. MCP provides a discount for two or more two-point IOC channels located between the same AT&T central offices, that have a digital office function obtained from this Tariff at each end, e.g., M-24 Multiplexing office function, transfer arrangements, Subrate Data Multiplexing or Customer Controlled Reconfiguration.
