SECTION 6 - TERRESTRIAL T1.5 LOCAL CHANNEL SERVICES

6.1 GENERAL (Cont'd)

6.1.5 Notice of Discontinuance - The Notice of Discontinuance for a Terrestrial T1.5 Local Channel Service or component is one month. Recurring charges apply for a period of one month from the date AT&T receives the discontinuance notice or until the requested discontinuance date, whichever is later. During this period, the charges will continue to apply whether or not the Customer continues to use the local channel service component.

6.1.6 Cancellation Charge - As specified in Section 2.5.8.B.1 preceding, a cancellation charge will apply for service orders canceled by the Customer on or after the SID.
