11.2 SERVICE COMPONENTS AND RATES (Cont'd)

11.2.2 Office Connections

- A. Access Connection - An access connection provides the function, at an AT&T central office, of connecting ACCU-Ring Network Access Service or other access to an IOC. One access connection applies for each other access connected.

- per OC12 connection	O41AC	ICB	ICB

Installation charges do not apply when the access connection is ordered for installation at the same time as an AT&T Private Line SONET Service. The AT&T Private Line SONET Service IOC must remain in service for at least 12 months. If the IOC is disconnected prior to the 12 months, the Customer is liable for a termination charge equal to the installation charge for the access connection.

- B. Function Connection - A function connection provides the function, at an AT&T central office, or connecting an office function to an IOC, another office function, an AT&T service, or of connecting an IOC to an AT&T service as specified in 3.3.2, preceding.
