## 11.2.3 Office Functions

A. SONET Multiplexing - the SONET multiplexing office function provides for the transmisson of multiple digital signals configured in either an office multiplexing, hubbing, linear add/drop configuration or ring configuration, for which the Customer has designated the configuration.
