13.1.5 Telecommunications Service Priority (TSP) Provisioning/Restoration Priority Charges (Cont'd)

- C. When an order for a TSP restoration priority level change is received, the following nonrecurring charge applies.

- Per service for TSP provisioning priority level change	NRZRS	-	\$52.50

- D. When special construction is necessary, the provisions and charges as set forth in Tariff P.C.S. No. 23 will apply.

- E. When a restoration priority is discontinued, no charge will apply.

13.1.6 Design Change Charge - A Design Change Charge applies each time a Customer requests a change of an order that results in a change in the design, operation or function of the private line service ordered. The Design Change Charge applies when a change in an order occurs after installation has started but prior to the due date.

13.1.7 Provision of a Design Layout Report - The Customer may order the design information pertaining to a private line service. This information is provided in a report referred to as a Design Layout Report. Design Layout Reports can only be provided on services ordered after the effective date of this tariff. A charge applies for the provision of the Design Layout Report.
