2.3.1 Liability (Cont'd)

- D. No license under patents (other than the limited license to use) is granted by AT&T or shall be implied or arise by estoppel, with respect to any private line service offered under this tariff. AT&T will defend the Customer and User against claims of patent infringement arising solely from the use by the Customer or User of private line services offered under this tariff and will indemnify such Customer or User for any damages awarded based solely on such claims.
- E. AT&T's failure to provide or maintain private line services under this tariff shall be excused by labor difficulties, governmental orders, civil commotions, preemption of existing services to restore service in compliance with Part 64, Subpart D, Appendix A, of the FCC's Rules and Regulations, natural catastrophes, and other circumstances beyond AT&T's reasonable control, subject to the provisions for Credit Allowances for Interruptions in this tariff.
