SECTION 2 - GENERAL REGULATIONS

2.1 UNDERTAKING OF AT&T

- 2.1.1 General - A private line service is furnished for the transmission of communications. It consists of one or more channels, office connections and may include channel options. A private line service may also consist solely of an office connection or solely of an office function.

A private line service is provided on a monthly basis.

AT&T is responsible for end-to-end service between Customers' premises when (1) a private line service uses the Access Coordination Function and a Local Channel, both furnished under Tariff P.S.C. No. 26 or (2) a private line service uses the Access Coordination Function furnished under Tariff P.S.C. No. 26 and other access. Service dates of components may be independent of each other when the Customer obtains access other than that furnished under Tariff P.S.C. No. 26.

AT&T does not transmit messages. However, the private line services it furnishes are suitable for that purpose.

- 2.1.2 Transmission Medium - AT&T selects and/or arranges the channels and/or equipment used to provide a private line service. AT&T may modify or change the channels and equipment at any time subject to the regulations in 2.8.1 following. Any suitable technology or combination of technologies may be used.

- 2.1.3 Provision of a Private Line Service - Private line services are offered under this tariff subject to the availability of suitable channels and equipment.

- A. Engineering, Installation and Maintenance - AT&T fully supports the private line services provided under this tariff through engineering, installation and maintenance efforts. AT&T will ensure that each private line service functions properly within its specified transmission, signaling or switching parameters. The characteristics of each type of private line service are described in the respective service sections.
