## SECTION 5 - CONSUMER SERVICE DESCRIPTIONS

### 5.1 DESCRIPTION (Cont'd)

#### 5.1.2 Non-Recurring Service Charges (Cont'd)

These charges are non-recurring and apply to various Customer requests for connecting, moving or changing service. They are in addition to any other scheduled rates and charges that would normally apply under this tariff.

##### A. Service Order Charge - New or Additional Line

This charge is for receiving, recording, and processing information necessary to execute a Customer's request for new or additional service. One Service Order Charge applies for all changes and/or additions ordered and provided at the same time, for the same Customer, for the same telephone line. It includes, but is not limited to charges for connections, moves, changes of equipment or service, changes of telephone number and wherever line or port, installation, connection, initial or other one time charges apply, except where otherwise specified. Charges are applicable, but not limited to the following:

- New or additional installation with or without premise visit
- PLOC Change, AKA PLOC Migration

These services are available where billing and facilities capabilities exist.

##### B. Service Order Charge - Move

This charge allows for customers who move within the same Central Office to retain their existing telephone number (area code, exchange and the last four digits). The nonrecurring charge will apply per account. If two or more accounts exist, the service order charge will apply per account. This charge does not include any other associated move charges. Inside wiring charge, installation charge, premise visit charges will all be billed separately. A service area code split, during or about the time of the customer's move, or other network or regulatory requirements may impact the ability of the company to provide this service.
