8.3.5 Discontinuance of an MSVPP-With Liability

Discontinuance of an MSVPP for reasons other than that stated in Paragraph 8.3.4, prior to the expiration of applicable term, will result in Customer liability as specified below:

- 1. For an MSVPP discontinued prior to the completion of the first year of service, the Customer in liable for 100 percent of the non-discounted MSVPP minimum monthly revenue commitment for the unexpired portion of the first year of service plus 50 percent of the non-discounted MSVPP minimum monthly revenue commitment for the remaining portion of the applicable term.
- 2. For an MSVPP discontinued after the completion of the first year of service, the Customer is liable for 50 percent of the non-discounted MSVPP minimum monthly revenue commitment for the unexpired portion of the applicable term.

Payment of the total amounts owed by the Customer under this regulation are due within thirty days of the date the plan is discontinued.

8.3.6 Expiration and Renewal of an MSVPP

Upon expiration of an MSVPP, the Customer has the option to obtain any MSVPP available or to obtain service under a monthly or other available plan.

The Customer may renew service under a new MSVPP or obtain service under any other payment plan available by notifying AT&T in writing anytime prior to the expiration of the current MSVPP.
