## SECTION 14 - MISCELLANEOUS EQUIPMENT AND ARRANGEMENTS

- 14.1 GENERAL This section contains miscellaneous equipment and arrangements that are provided for use with local channel services offered under this tariff.
- 14.1.1 Regulations In addition to the regulations in Section 2, preceding, the following applies.
  - A. Minimum Payment Period Unless otherwise specified in this Section, miscellaneous equipment and arrangements are furnished for the same minimum payment period as that specified for the local channel service with which the equipment or arrangement is associated.
- 14.2 MISCELLANEOUS EQUIPMENT AND ARRANGEMENTS FOR USE WITH VOICE GRADE LOCAL CHANNEL SERVICES IN LATA 132, 133, 134, 136, 138, 140 AND 921
- 14.2.1 <u>Automatic Voice Connecting Arrangements</u> These arrangements provide compatibility between Customer equipment and a Voice Grade Local Channel Service. The provision of connecting arrangements is limited to those already in service to connect grandfathered Customer equipment. No new arrangements will be provided.
  - A. This arrangement connects a local channel to a Customer-provided multiline terminating system arranged for dial or automatic signaling. The local channel must terminate at the distant end as a trunk in the switching equipment arranged for dial or automatic signaling.

This connecting arrangement provides network control signaling functions. The Customer must specify two-wire or four-wire termination and Type I (E & M) or Type II (contact-closure) signaling leads.
