SECTION 14 - MISCELLANEOUS EQUIPMENT AND ARRANGEMENTS

- 14.3 STANDARD JACKS - REGISTRATION PROGRAM - Standard jacks are services subject to the Registration Program. These jacks are contained in Part 68 of the FCC's Rules and Regulations or the document on file with the FCC entitled "Descriptions of Standard Registration Program Connection Configurations Supplementing Configurations Described in Subpart F of Part 68 of the FCC's Rules and Regulations."
- These arrangements are used to terminate local channel services provided by AT&T. Other services provided by AT&T or services provided by others may also be terminated in any spare capacity of a jack that remains after its installation. No additional charge applies for the use of such capacity. The standard jacks (USOC) and their typical usages are described below.
