##### 14.2.1 Automatic Voice Connecting Arrangements (Cont'd)

- B. This arrangement connects a two-way local channel from the attendant position or from the dial switching equipment of a Customer-provided multiline terminating system operating in the ground start mode. The local channel must terminate at the distant end as a station in a PBX or Centrex system. This PBX or Centrex system must also operate in the ground start mode.
