10.2 VOICE GRADE LOCAL CHANNEL SERVICE RATES (Cont'd)

10.2.6 Channel Options - The following channel options are available for use with Voice Grade Local Channel Services.

- A. Conditioning - Conditioning provides more specific transmission characteristics for Voice Grade Local Channel Services. For two-point local channel services the parameters apply to each local channel. For multipoint local channel services, the parameters apply between two communicating points. The types of conditioning which are available are C-Type conditioning, D-Type conditioning. The specifications for each type of conditioning are set forth in Section 6 of Technical Publications-PUB 62501 (see Technical Publication Information, Preface).

1. C-Type Conditioning - The rates for C-Type conditioning apply per termination (each Customer's premises) arranged on a local channel service and are as follows:
