7.13 AT&T All In One (Cont'd)

7.13.2 Monthly Usage Cap:

AT&T Local Exchange Service Customers who select flat rate Local Exchange Services in conjunction with their use of AT&T All In One Plan A Flat Rate*, Plan B Flat Rate** and Plan K Flat Rate will be charged a per-line monthly flat rate that entitles the Customer to the use of the local business line and local calling at no additional charge up to a maximum of (1) for AT&T All In One Plan A Flat Rate Service, 1,500 minutes of local calling in any billing period; (2) for AT&T All In One Rate Plan B** Service 1,450 minutes of local calling in any billing period; (3) for AT&T All In One Rate Plan K Flat Rate Service 1,400 minutes of local calling in any billing period. In billing periods in which such Customers exceed the maximum minutes of local calling per-line, available under the applicable plan, for all local minutes in excess of the designated maximum minutes, the Customer will be billed in full minute increments that is equal to the AT&T Local Exchange Services usage rate, as stated in the Price List. Fractional minutes will be rounded up to the next full minute increment. All lines at the customer's location must be subscribed to the same plan.

AT&T All In One Advantage Plan and AT&T All In One Advantage Term Plan will be charged a flat monthly rate per-line that entitles the customer the use of the local business line, unlimited local calling, and optional features as described following.

- * AT&T All In One Rate Plan A is not available either under this tariff or through any AT&T Contract Tariff or contract referencing this tariff to new customers who did not have it on order before March 3, 2003. Existing customers with AT&T All In One Rate Plan A in effect or on order prior to March 3, 2003 will continue to receive service pursuant to the plan under existing conditions, including with respect to the addition of new lines to existing service, unless and until such customers request service pursuant to an alternate plan.
- ** Effective September 1, 2006, AT&T All In One Rate Plan B is not available to newly subscribed customers. Existing customers with Rate Plan B in effect or on order prior to September 1, 2006 may continue with their current plan under existing conditions. Existing customers may add new lines and/or features, but no new locations are permitted.
