- E. Initial and Additional Periods (Cont'd)
 - 2. Timing of Messages
 - a. On AT&T PRO WATS/Plan Q Service in New York calls, chargeable time begins when connection is established between the calling telephone and the called telephone, Miscellaneous Common Carrier mobile radio system or PBX System.
 - b. Chargeable time ends when the calling station "hangs-up", thereby releasing the network connection. If the called station "hangs-up" but the calling station does not, chargeable time ends when the network connection is released by automatic timing equipment in the telephone network.
 - c. Chargeable time does not include time lost because of faults or defects in the service.
 - d. When AT&T PRO WATS/Plan Q Service in New York is connected to a Customer provided communications system through a service terminating arrangement or connecting arrangement, under the provisions of Paragraph C. of Section 1 of P.S.C. No. 23--Telephone, chargeable time begins when a call from the telecommunications network terminates in or passes through the first multi-line terminating system or terminal equipment on that communications system. It is the Customer's responsibility to furnish appropriate answer supervision to the point of connection with the telephone service so that chargeable time may begin.
