33.2 Regulations (cont'd)

D. When AT&T PRO WATS New York service is connected to a Customer provided communications system through a service terminating arrangement or connecting arrangement, under the provisions of Paragraph C. of Section 1 of P.S.C. No. 23-- Telephone, chargeable time begins when a call from the telecommunications network terminates in or passes through the first multi-line terminating system or terminal equipment on that communications system. It is the Customer's responsibility to furnish appropriate answer supervision to the point of connection with the telephone service so that chargeable time may begin.

F. Initial and Additional Period Rates

1. The initial period rates are for one minute or fraction thereof.
2. All additional period rates are for each additional minute or fractional part thereof that the telephone connection continues beyond the initial period.

G. Procedure for Ascertaining a Rate

In order to find the rate between two points the steps to be followed are:

1. Ascertain the rate mileage as described in C. preceding.
2. Refer to the rates in Paragraph c.(4) following, as appropriate. Opposite the Rate Step and the Rate Airline Mileage as determined in (a) above will be found the initial and additional period rates between the rate centers involved.
