SECTION 36 - AT&T STATE CALLING SERVICE*

36.1 DESCRIPTION

36.1.1 General

AT&T State Calling Service is a switched telecommunications service furnished only to state and local government entities which permits interactive communications between stations located within the State of New York. It is available only to Customers who subscribe to interstate State Calling Service. AT&T State Calling Service is available under Option 1 or Option 2. AT&T State Calling Service Option 1 provides calling from on-network stations in New York or from off-network stations in New York with use of the Network Remote Access optional features, to other locations in New York. AT&T State Calling Service Option 2 provides outward calling from designated AT&T central offices to stations throughout New York. Since New York AT&T State Calling Service is an add-on to interstate State Calling Service, all terms and conditions will apply as described in AT&T's Business Service Guide, including installation and monthly charges. Intrastate usage will be billed at the rates listed in Section 36.3.1.

- * State Calling Option 1 is not available, either under this tariff section or through any AT&T MSA, ASA or contract referencing this tariff section, to new or existing Customers who did not have it on order on or before July 31, 2001. Existing Customers with SCS Option 1 in effect or on order prior to July 31, 2001 may continue under existing conditions. AT&T MSA, ASA or contracts in effect or on order on July 31, 2001 which include SCS Option 1 shall also continue under existing conditions. Availability of SCS Option 1 to customers taking the Service pursuant to an AT&T MSA, ASA or contract will not extend beyond the current term of the applicable MSA, ASA or contract.
