## SECTION 2 - GENERAL REGULATIONS

### 2.11 DEFINITIONS (Cont'd)

#### Called Station

The station (e.g., telephone number) called, or the terminating point of a call.

#### Calling Card

A card authorized by this Company to which the charges for an AT&T LDS call may be billed. A calling Card may be any AT&T Card, AT&T CIID/891 Card, a Local Exchange Company Card or its equivalent, or a commercial credit/charge card.

#### Calling Station

The station from which a call is originated.

#### Commercial Credit Card

The term "Commercial Credit Card" denotes a billing arrangement by which a call may be charged to an authorized commercial credit card number.

#### Company

AT&T Communications of New York, Inc., and the American Telephone and Telegraph Company, Interstate Division (AT&T Communications).

#### Customer

The person or legal entity which orders service (either direct or through an agent).

#### Customer-Provided Communications System

Dedicated private line channels and equipment (e.g., microwave or cable system) furnished by the Customer for communications between premises.
