Gas System Benefits Charge (GSBC)

The charges set forth herein shall be subject to **a Gas** System Benefits Charge per 100 cu bic feet of gas supplied for residential aggregation customers only, as explained on leaf No. 77.

Reserved

The specific rate for reserved service shall be calculated monthly and shall be filed with the Public Service Commission. The Rate shall be equal to the above rates for unreserved status plus the difference between the average cost of gas and the commodity cost of gas.

Increase in Rates and Charges

A per unit charge (transition surcharge) shall be added to collect the costs of the Company's stranded capacity costs as described on Leaf 78. The rate shall be provided in a monthly statement to be filed with the Commission.

The rates and charges under this service classification including the Minimum Charge will be increased by the applicable percentage for service supplied within the municipality where the customer is taking service.

Application of Deliveries and Balancing

All volumes consumed by customer shall be billed at the above rates. Customers shall follow the balancing rules described in General Information Section W5 on leaf 81 of the Company's tariff. A per unit balancing charge shall apply to all transportation volumes. The rate shall be one-tenth of the Company's annualized per unit cost of storage from the monthly GAC computation. The rate shall be provided in a monthly statement to be filed with the Public Service Commission.
