

Local and Joint Toll Tariff

3. General Regulations
3.1 Application of Tariff

3.1.1	Scope
A.	This tariff applies to intrastate intraLATA message toll telephone service furnished by Verizon New York Inc., (hereinafter referred to as the Telephone Company), in conformity with the designated carrier plan.
1.	Message toll telephone service is that of furnishing facilities for telephone communication between telephones in different local calling areas in accordance with the regulations and schedules of charges specified in this tariff.
2.	Designated Carrier Plan— As stipulated in the designated carrier plan settlement agreement approved by the PSC in Opinion No. 92–13, issued and effective May 29, 1992, Telephone Company toll rates apply to all intrastate intraLATA toll calls (0-, 0+, 1+) made in the Albany, Binghamton, Buffalo, Poughkeepsie and Syracuse LATAs, whether made by customers of the Telephone Company or of an independent telephone company and whether or not the call traverses the Telephone Company's network, so long as the call is not directed to another carrier by 10XXX dialing.
B.	This tariff is governed, except as otherwise provided herein, by PSC NY No. 900, which tariff, revised and added pages or superseding issues thereof, are hereby made a part of this tariff.
C.	The toll service charges specified in this tariff are in payment for all service furnished between the calling and called telephone, except as otherwise provided in this tariff.
D.	For the purposes of this tariff and unless otherwise specified, following are the LATAs (as defined in Section 2.3.2) or LATA/Market areas of this tariff.

2.	LATA 133–Poughkeepsie
3.	LATA 134–Albany
4.	LATA 136–Syracuse
