SECTION 4 - REGIONAL CALLING**4.1 General****4.1.1 Description**

Regional Calling Service is furnished for telephone communications in New York City to seven regions (specified below) within the New York Metropolitan LATA (New York Metro) in accordance with the regulations and schedules of charges specified in this tariff. The usage charges specified in Section 4.5 below are in payment for all service furnished between the calling and called telephone, except as otherwise provided in this Tariff.

Regional Calling includes the following types of calls: direct dialed, calling card, collect, 3rd number billed, special toll billing, requests to notify of time and charges, and person to person calling.

The New York Metro LATA is divided into seven Regions whose boundaries are defined by political, commercial and social mutuality of interest. The Regions are:

New York City (Home Region)	Lower Westchester
Nassau	Upper Westchester
West Suffolk	Rockland
East Suffolk	

The exchanges of Byram and Greenwich in Connecticut are part of the New York Metro LATA, but are not part of the Regional Calling specified above.
