2.7 Payment For Service, (Cont'd.)

2.7.7 Residential Installment Billing

Residential Customers may elect to pay their service connection, initial installation, move, substitution and other non-recurring charges associated with service orders including restoral charges and maintenance of service charges in monthly installments for up to a twelve (12) month period. When installment billing is requested, it will be applied to all non-recurring charges associated with a given service order, subject to the following:

- (A) Charges will be billed in twelve (12) monthly installments, of equal dollar amounts as requested by the Customer but the Customer may choose a shorter payment period.
- (B) A Customer may not pay a portion of the charges and then request installment billing for the remaining charges.
- (C) A Customer may elect to pay the unbilled charges before the expiration of the installment plan.
- (D) More than one installment plan may be in effect for the same Customer at the same time.
- (E) If a Customer disconnects service during the installment payment period all unbilled charges will be included in the final bill rendered.
- (F) Installment billing payments will continue even though an account is temporarily suspended.
- (G) No interest or carrying charges will be applied to the outstanding balance during the installment period.
