SECTION 2 – RULES AND REGULATIONS

2.15 Special Pricing Arrangements

Customized service packages at negotiated rates may be furnished on a case-by-case basis in response to requests by Customers of BellSouth Long Distance for proposals or for competitive bids. Service offered under this tariff provision will be provided to Customers pursuant to contract. Unless otherwise specified, the regulations for such arrangements are in addition to the applicable regulations and prices in other sections of the tariff. Specialized rates or charges will be made available to similarly situated Customers on a non-discriminatory basis and are listed in the Addendum to this tariff with the following information: (1) the LATA in which the Customer is located, (2) the horizontal and vertical distance from the central office to the Customer's premises, (3) the type of service, (4) the price of the service, (5) the number of lines (circuits) being used and (6) the length of the contract terms.

2.16 Gross Revenue Tax Surcharge

The applicable Gross Revenue Surcharge rates and MTA tax rates are shown on a statement which is attached to this tariff. Any changes to these rates will be filed on 15 days' notice to Customers and the Commission, or as directed by the Commission. Customers will be notified of any changes by bill insert or separate mailing no later than the first billing period following the date of change. Whenever the state levies a new tax on the Company's gross revenues, repeals such a tax, or changes the rate of such tax, the Commission may approve new surcharge factors, and the company will file revised surcharges as directed by the Commission.

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
