Calls made with a Prepaid Phone Card are rounded up to the next full minute. If a partial minute is used, then the card will be charged for a full minute. There will be a surcharge for calls made from pay phones as set forth in Section 4 of this tariff. A per Telecom Unit 800 surcharge will be charged if a local access number is printed on the card, but the customer chooses to call the 800 access number instead.
