LARGE GENERAL FIRM SERVICE (Cont'd)

Customers anticipating that they will, or desiring to, overrun their Contract Volume may be able to have such overrun authorized. Customers must notify the Company in advance of any such event. The Company reserves the right to impose unauthorized overrun penalties if such advance notice is not given and the overrun is not authorized. The ratchet provision described above will not apply to overruns authorized in advance. The Company shall keep a record of every request for an Authorized Overrun and disposition thereof.

Character of Service:

Natural gas with not less than 950 Btu per cubic foot, at pressures to be agreed upon, but not less than 4 inches water column. Service provided under this Service Classification shall not be subject to curtailment or interruption, except by reason of force majeure, and deliveries of firm service hereunder shall have priority over all deliveries to be made by company on an interruptible service basis.

Services Available:

The following services are available under this Service Classification:

Sales Service: For the continuous supply of natural gas by company including associated Distribution Delivery, Gas Interconnection, Gas Transportation, Gas Supply, and Load Balancing services necessary to ensure delivery in accordance with customer's needs. For this service, the Distribution Delivery, Gas Interconnection, Gas Transportation, Gas Supply, and Load Balancing Charges shall apply to all volumes through the meter.

Reserved Unbundled Transportation Service: For the continuous delivery of contract quantities of natural gas owned by customer (or by a party with a contract with customer to supply customer's natural gas requirements) from a contractually specified Point of Receipt to a contractually specified Point of Delivery where company's distribution system interconnects with the facilities of customer. Company reserves the right, acting reasonably, to limit the volume of gas that may be received at each Point of Receipt.

Customers or customers' Agent must have transmission arrangements to a Point of Receipt that are for firm service on the upstream transmission pipeline system.
