RATE CHOICES AVAILABLE TO CUSTOMERS: (CONT'D.)

c) Additional Component: An additional credit ("Adder") in the amount of \$0.001 per kWh.

The Energy Component and Capacity Component [(a) and (b) above] will be combined to appear as a single line item credit on each customer bill. The Additional Component [(c) above] will also appear as a separate single line item credit on each customer bill.

NYSEG will provide Delivery and Commodity Service for the two Non-Retail Access choices.

3. NYSEG Fixed Price Option (FPO)

This Non-Retail Access choice includes fixed charges for delivery service, a fluctuating Transition Charge (Non-Bypassable Charge [NBC]), a fluctuating commodity charge for electricity supplied by NYSEG and a Merchant Function Charge.
