#### 1. ESCO Price Option (EPO)

This Retail Access choice includes a monthly maintenance charge for luminaires and other company-owned facilities in service, fixed charges for NYSEG delivery service, and a fluctuating Transition Charge (Non-Bypassable Charge [NBC]).

Kilowatt-hour use will be determined in accordance with General Information Section 2, Determination of Demand and Energy Use.
